We have reviewed your organization's online defensive driving program provider application and are pleased to inform you that DriveSafeToday.com, Inc has been approved as an authorized online defensive driving program provider in the State of New Jersey. This approval is considered indefinite subject to continued compliance with defensive driving course provider regulations by you and any affiliates you may have.

Please note that signed (by you or authorized representative) student attendance rosters must be submitted within 10 business days of the date of course completion. This is very important since the Motor Vehicle Commission (MVC) receives inquiries from drivers when there is a delay in posting course completion on the driver record. You may use one roster for different class dates, provided the rosters will be received by the Driver Education office within 10 business days of the earliest completion date on the roster. Separate rosters must be used for each affiliate that provides the course.

You may inform your customers that successful completion of an online defensive driving course may earn them a two point reduction and/or auto premium reduction in accordance with the N.J.S.A. 17:33-B45 and N.J.S.A. 17:33-B45.1. Additionally, customers should be advised that course completion cannot be used to reduce future points, and can only be credited once every five years, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 39:5-30.9. Furthermore, questions related to vehicle insurance rate reductions should be directed to the insurance provider. It has been our experience that these questions and customer concerns are frequently and mistakenly directed to the course provider and the MVC.

Continuing education of drivers is consistent with the MVC's mission and can help make New Jersey roads safer. We look forward to working with your organization as you provide online defensive driving courses to New Jersey drivers.
